The goal of the Junior Green Jeans is to teach children/families how to manage a vegetable garden without traditional watering and use of synthetic fertilizers/pesticides. Children/families work together to research, plant and tend to the garden.

- ✂ A \$25 family “greens fee” enrolls you and your kids in a community based vegetable garden cooperative.
- ✂ Family co-op members will research, plant, and grow an organic vegetable garden.
- ✂ Any produce grown will be sold at BFSC’s Farm Market Fridays with a portion of the sales donated to a local food pantry to help local families in need become more sustainable.
- ✂ Children/families will create a written and/or video journal of their experiences: noting what was effective/successful and why; what was not effective/successful and why.
